

## Prevent Duty Guidance and Promoting British Values Policy

As part of my role as a Childminder, I have a duty to keep myself up to date with all legislation involved with Safeguarding the children in my setting.

Most recent documentation includes the new Prevent Duty Guidance which Childminders' must comply with as of July 2015. The document can be found here:

The counter Terrorism and Security Act places a duty on Early Years settings to "have due regard to the need to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism". The new documentation will be used and referred to alongside other safeguarding documents such as "Keeping children safe is everyone's responsibility" and information referring to British values.

Within the EYFS I will promote British Values in many ways, teaching children from right and wrong at an early age. I will teach about decision making (PSED) and democracy- and about respecting each other's views and values, talking about feelings and learning to share ideas and take turns during play.

I will also promote the importance of having rules and boundaries in place and the importance of those rules.

PSED (personal, Social and emotional development) and UW(Understanding the World) also teach children to have a positive sense of themselves, and to believe in their own abilities and to challenge themselves. As part of UW and PSED I celebrate diversity, embracing different cultures and introducing children whenever possible to different to different ways of Life. I will use resources and create activities that challenge gender, cultural and racial stereotyping.

I will make sure children have access to the wider community and resources promoting this. I will encourages children not to stereotype and to be considerate and accepting of others, despite their differences and to respect each other. Any unwanted or behavior showing otherwise will be monitored and with parent involvement procedures will be put in place.

Older children will be monitored in ICT equipment with the use of parental controls to limit what they do on the internet.
